- Concerns over the scope of the reporting of crime since the implimentation of the new format, too broad to be of any use to Felmingham since it now covers the entire electoral ward. PCSO advised that this was unlikely to change now and that the new system does not readily lend itself to more detailed analysis.
 - Attendance of the PCSO at future parish meetings. Chairman suggested that future parish meeting dates should be set on an annual basis that would tie in, where possible, with the PCSO shift pattern to enable him to attend.
